Read about each of Allah's Beautiful Names. Each one tells you something amazing about Him!

### #1 Allaah

#### The God

Allah is the most special Name! It means the One we love, worship, and turn to for everything. All the other beautiful Names belong to Him.

**Example:** When you feel happy, you say *Alhamdulillah*. When you need help, you say *Yaa Allah*. He is the One you always talk to in your heart!

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### #2 Ar-Rabb

#### The Lord & Nurturer

Allah is your Rabb — He made you, He takes care of you, and He helps you grow from a tiny baby into who you are today!

**Example:** Think about a little seed in the ground. Allah sends it rain, sunshine, and soil so it grows into a big tree. He does the same for you!

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### #3 Al-Ilaah

#### The One Worthy of Worship

Only Allah deserves to be worshiped. He is the only One who can truly help us and answer our prayers.

**Example:** When you make *dua* before a test or when you're scared, you ask Allah — not a toy, not a star, not anything else — because only He can really help!

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### #4 Al-Ahad

#### The Unique

Allah is completely unique — there is absolutely nothing and nobody like Him at all. He is one of a kind!

**Example:** Even if you search the whole universe, every planet and every galaxy, you will never find anyone like Allah. He is the only One!

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#5  الواحد Al-Waahid

**The One and Only**

Allah is the One and Only. He has no partner, no helper, and no one is equal to Him. He does everything by Himself — He needs no help!

**Example:** *People need teams to build a house, but Allah created the entire universe — the sun, moon, stars, and earth — all by Himself!*

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#6  الوتر Al-Witr

**The Single**

Allah is Single and alone in being God. No one shares His power or His position. He needs no one to help Him.

**Example:** *When you pray Witr at night, you remember that Allah is Al-Witr — the One and Only, with no partner at all!*

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#7  الأول Al-Awwal

**The First**

Allah was there before anything else existed — before the sky, before the earth, before time itself. He has always been there!

**Example:** *Before there were dinosaurs, before there were oceans, before there was even space — Allah was already there. He has no beginning!*

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#8  الآخر Al-Aakhir

**The Last**

Allah will remain forever, even after everything else is gone. He will never ever end!

**Example:** *Mountains will crumble, stars will go out, and oceans will dry up one day — but Allah will still be there, forever and ever!*

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#9  الظاهر Adh-Dhaahir

**The Uppermost**

Allah is the Highest — above everything! Nothing is above Him. He is greater and higher than anything you can imagine.

**Example:** *If you look up at the sky and the stars way up high, know that Allah is above all of that! He is the Most High.*

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#10  **الباطن** Al-Baatin

**The Innermost**

Allah knows everything hidden and secret — even what's deep inside. He knows what is inside your heart and what you are thinking right now!

**Example:** *Even if you have a secret thought that you never told anyone — not even your best friend — Allah already knows it!*

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#11  **الرحمن** Ar-Rahmaan

**The Most Merciful**

Allah's love and care is SO big that it covers everything and everyone in the whole world — even animals, plants, and people who don't know Him yet!

**Example:** *The air you breathe, the water you drink, the sun that keeps you warm — Allah gives all of this to everyone because His mercy is HUGE!*

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#12  **الرحيم** Ar-Raheem

**The Bestower of Mercy**

Allah shows His mercy and kindness to you in so many ways every single day. He actively takes care of you with love!

**Example:** *When you were sick and then got better, that was Allah's mercy reaching you. When your mum gives you a warm hug, that love comes from Ar-Raheem!*

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#13  **الودود** Al-Wadood

**The Loving One**

Allah loves His good servants and they love Him back! His love is the most special and beautiful love there is.

**Example:** *When you do something kind — like sharing your lunch or helping someone — Allah loves you even more! And the more you know Him, the more you love Him!*

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#14  البر Al-Barr

**The Most Kind**

Allah treats everyone with kindness and goodness. He gives us so many good things and fixes our problems!

**Example:** *Even when things seem hard, Allah is working behind the scenes to make things better for you — like when a rainy day helps the flowers grow!*

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#15  الرؤوف Ar-Ra'oof

**The Compassionate**

Allah is full of compassion — He cares about you deeply and shows mercy even when things are difficult.

**Example:** *When you fall down and scrape your knee, Allah made your body able to heal itself! He is so compassionate that He built healing right into you.*

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#16  الحفي Al-Hafiyy

**The Benevolent**

Allah is always kind to you and always listening when you call on Him. He never ignores you!

**Example:** *Even if you feel like nobody is paying attention to you, Allah always is. He is the most kind and caring, and He always hears your dua!*

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#17  الرفيق Ar-Rafeeq

**The Gentle**

Allah is gentle in everything He does. He doesn't rush things — He creates and plans everything step by step with care.

**Example:** *Think about how a baby grows slowly — first crawling, then standing, then walking. Allah does things gently, one step at a time!*

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#18  الأكرم Al-Akram

**The Most Generous**

Allah is the MOST generous — more generous than anyone you can ever imagine. No one can out-give Allah!

**Example:** If you give one pound in charity, Allah can reward you with ten times more or even seven hundred times more! He is the Most Generous!

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#19  **الكريم** Al-Kareem

**The Bountiful**

Allah keeps giving and giving, even to people who forget to thank Him. His generosity never stops!

**Example:** Even people who don't pray or say thank you still get sunshine, air, food, and water from Allah. That's how generous He is!

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#20  **الجواد** Al-Jawaad

**The Munificent**

Allah gives SO generously to everyone — His giving is like an ocean that never runs out!

**Example:** Every night, Allah comes close and asks, 'Who wants something? I will give it to them!' He LOVES to give!

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#21  **القيظ** Al-Qaabid

**The Withholder**

Sometimes Allah holds something back from you, but it's always because He knows what's best for you!

**Example:** Imagine you really wanted sweets before dinner, but your mum said no — because she knew dinner was better for you. Allah withholds things for good reasons too!

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#22  **الباسط** Al-Baasit

**The Expander**

Allah opens up good things for you and makes your life full of blessings when the time is right!

**Example:** Sometimes you feel a bit sad, and then suddenly something wonderful happens — a fun day out or good news. That's Allah expanding your happiness!

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#23  **المانع** Al-Mani'

**The Preventer**

Allah sometimes stops certain things from reaching you because He is protecting you from something bad!

**Example:** *Maybe you didn't get something you really wanted, but later you found out it would have been bad for you. Allah was protecting you all along!*

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#24  المعطي **Al-Mu'tee**

**The Giver**

Allah gives to whoever He knows should receive. Every good thing you have is a gift from Him!

**Example:** *Your ability to see, hear, walk, and think — these are all gifts Allah chose to give you. He gives each person exactly what they need!*

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#25  الوهاب **Al-Wahhaab**

**The Bestower**

Allah gives gifts freely, again and again, without anyone having to earn them. He never gets tired of giving!

**Example:** *Every morning when you wake up healthy and safe, that's a free gift from Allah! You didn't have to do anything — He just gave it to you!*

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#26  المنان **Al-Mannaan**

**The Beneficent Bestower**

Every single good thing in your life comes from Allah. He is the source of ALL blessings!

**Example:** *Your family, your home, your friends, your food, even the ability to laugh and smile — all of these blessings started with Allah!*

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#27  الرزاق **Ar-Razzaaq**

**The Great Provider**

Allah provides everything that every single creature needs — food, water, air, and even guidance for your heart! Ar-Razzaaq gives again and again in huge amounts.

**Example:** *Think about your breakfast this morning — Allah made sure the food grew, got to the shop, and reached your plate! He feeds the whole world!*

---

#28  الرازق **Ar-Raaziq**

## The Sustainer

Allah gives sustenance to everyone — not a single creature is forgotten! While Ar-Razzaaq means huge, continuous provision, Ar-Raaziq tells us He provides for all.

**Example:** *Even a tiny ant underground and a fish deep in the ocean — Allah makes sure they all get their food every single day!*

---

## #29 اللطيف Al-Lateef

### The Subtle & Kind

Allah knows every tiny detail about you, and He brings good things to you in ways you never expected!

**Example:** *Sometimes when you're feeling sad, a friend suddenly says something nice, or you find something that makes you smile. That's Allah being Al-Lateef!*

---

## #30 الحى Al-Hayiy

### The Honorably Shy

Allah is so generous and honorable that when you raise your hands and ask Him for something, He does not turn you away empty-handed!

**Example:** *Imagine you asked someone for help and they were too kind and generous to say no — that's a tiny bit like Allah! He is too generous to let your dua go unanswered!*

---

## #31 الحى Al-Hayy

### The Ever-Living

Allah is alive and has always been alive. He never sleeps, never gets tired, and He will live forever!

**Example:** *People need sleep every night, but Allah NEVER sleeps — not even for one second! He is always awake, always watching over you!*

---

## #32 القيوم Al-Qayyoom

### The Self-Sustaining

Allah keeps everything running! Every star, every heartbeat, every leaf that falls — it all depends on Him!

**Example:** *Your heart beats about 100,000 times a day without you thinking about it. Who keeps it going? Allah, Al-Qayyoom!*

---

#33  الصمد **As-Samad**

**The Eternal Lord**

Allah is the One everyone needs, but He doesn't need anyone. He is perfect and complete all by Himself!

**Example:** *When you're hungry, you need food. When you're cold, you need a blanket. But Allah never needs anything at all — everyone needs Him!*

---

#34  الغني **Al-Ghaniyy**

**The Self-Sufficient**

Allah doesn't need anything from anyone! He doesn't need our food, our help, or our money. He is completely free of any need!

**Example:** *When you give charity or pray, it doesn't help Allah — it helps YOU! Allah doesn't need it, but He loves you for doing it!*

---

#35  الخالق **Al-Khaaliq**

**The Creator**

Allah made everything from nothing! The sky, the stars, the animals, and you! He just says 'Be!' and it is!

**Example:** *Before there was anything — no light, no sound, no space — Allah created it all. He didn't need any tools or materials. Just 'Kun fa yakoon!'*

---

#36  الخلاق **Al-Khallaq**

**The Constant Creator**

Allah creates and creates and never stops! He keeps making new things easily, without any effort at all!

**Example:** *Every single day, new babies are born, new flowers bloom, and new snowflakes fall — each one unique! Allah never stops creating!*

---

#37  الباري **Al-Baari'**

**The Originator**

Allah designed every living thing in its own special way, like nothing that existed before!

**Example:** *Look at a giraffe with its long neck, a pufferfish that blows up, and a chameleon that changes colour — Allah made each one original and amazing!*

---

#38  المصور **Al-Musawwir**

**The Fashioner of Forms**

Allah gave everything its own shape and look. He designed your face, your fingerprints, and the stripes on every zebra!

**Example:** *Out of billions of people in the world, nobody has the same fingerprints as you! Allah fashioned you to be one of a kind!*

---

#39  الهادي **Al-Haadi**

**The Guide**

Allah shows everyone the right path! He guides the birds to fly south, the bees to find flowers, and your heart to find truth!

**Example:** *When you learn something beautiful from the Quran and it makes your heart feel warm and happy — that's Allah guiding you!*

---

#40  الفتح **Al-Fattaah**

**The Opener & Judge**

Allah opens doors of goodness for you and judges between people fairly. When something feels stuck, He can open the way!

**Example:** *If you ever feel stuck or worried, make dua to Al-Fattaah and watch — Allah can open a way out that you never imagined!*

---

#41  الحكم **Al-Hakam**

**The Judge**

Allah is the fairest Judge ever. He sees everything and will always give everyone exactly what they deserve!

**Example:** *If someone is mean to you and gets away with it, don't worry — Allah sees everything and will judge perfectly on the Day of Judgement!*

---

#42  الحكيم **Al-Hakeem**

**The All-Wise**

Allah does everything with perfect wisdom. Nothing He does is random — there is always a wise reason behind it!

**Example:** *Even if you don't understand why something happens, trust that Allah has a wise plan. Like how rain seems annoying but makes everything grow!*

---

#43  **العليم** Al-'Aleem

**The All-Knowing**

Allah knows absolutely EVERYTHING — what happened before, what's happening now, and what will happen next!

**Example:** *Even the number of leaves on every tree and the number of drops in the ocean — Allah knows the exact count of everything!*

---

#44  **العالم** Al-'Aalim

**Knower of Seen & Unseen**

Allah knows everything that is hidden and everything that is out in the open. Nothing can be kept secret from Him!

**Example:** *Even if something is buried deep underground or hidden behind a million walls, Allah knows exactly where it is and what it is!*

---

#45  **الخبير** Al-Khabeer

**The Fully Aware**

Allah is fully aware of everything — He knows what will help you and what will harm you, even before it happens!

**Example:** *When your parents stop you from touching a hot stove, they know it will hurt. Allah's awareness is even greater — He knows EVERYTHING that's coming!*

---

#46  **السميع** As-Samee'

**The All-Hearing**

Allah hears everything — every word, every whisper, even the thoughts in your heart that you never say out loud!

**Example:** *Even if you whisper a tiny dua in your heart and nobody else can hear it, Allah hears every word!*

---

#47  البصير Al-Baseer

**The All-Seeing**

Allah sees everything — nothing is hidden from Him, not even a black ant on a dark rock on a dark night!

**Example:** When you do a good deed and nobody sees it — like picking up rubbish when no one is looking — Allah sees it and is pleased with you!

---

#48  الأعلى Al-A'laa

**The Most High**

Allah is the Most High above all things! He is higher and greater than anything in the heavens and the earth.

**Example:** When you say 'SubhaanaRabbiyal-A'laa' in sujud, you are praising the One who is higher than everything!

---

#49  العلي Al-'Aliyy

**The Exalted**

Allah is above everything — above the sky, above the heavens — nothing is higher or mightier than Him!

**Example:** Aeroplanes fly high, rockets go higher, stars are even higher — but Allah is above ALL of that!

---

#50  المتعالي Al-Muta'aalee

**The Supremely Exalted**

Allah is so far above everything that our minds can't even fully understand how great He is!

**Example:** Even the biggest, most powerful thing you can think of is tiny compared to Allah. He is greater than ANYTHING you can imagine!

---

#51  الملك Al-Malik

**The King**

Allah is the true King of everything! Every king, queen, and leader is nothing compared to His Kingship!

**Example:** Kings have castles and countries, but Allah owns the ENTIRE universe — every planet, star, and galaxy belongs to Him!

---

#52  **المليك** Al-Maleek

**The Omnipotent Sovereign**

Allah is the All-Powerful King who can do absolutely anything He wants. Nothing can stop Him!

**Example:** *A king might have power over one country, but Allah has power over everything — even over all the kings! He controls it all!*

---

#53  **السيد** As-Sayyid

**The Lord & Master**

Allah is the Master of everyone and everything. We are all His creation and depend on Him!

**Example:** *Just like everyone in a school needs the headteacher, everyone in the whole universe needs Allah — He is the Master of all!*

---

#54  **الكبير** Al-Kabeer

**The Greatest**

Allah is the Greatest! He is bigger, stronger, and more important than anything and everything else!

**Example:** *When you say 'Allaahu Akbar' in salah, you are saying Allah is Greater — greater than your worries, your problems, and everything else!*

---

#55  **العظيم** Al-'Adheem

**The Tremendous**

Allah is so tremendous and magnificent that only He truly deserves to be held in awe. He is absolutely amazing!

**Example:** *When you look at a thunderstorm with lightning and rumbling clouds, remember — the One who made that is even more awesome and tremendous!*

---

#56  **العزیز** Al-'Azeez

**The Almighty**

Allah is the Almighty — nothing and nobody can beat Him or overpower Him. He always wins!

**Example:** *If all the people in the world got together to try to stop Allah's plan, they couldn't! He is the Almighty and nothing can defeat Him!*

---

#57  القوي **Al-Qawiyy**

**The Perfect in Strength**

Allah has perfect strength that never runs out. He never gets tired or weak — ever!

**Example:** *After running around, you get tired. After carrying something heavy, your arms ache. But Allah NEVER gets tired — His strength is perfect!*

---

#58  المتين **Al-Mateen**

**The Strong**

Allah is the Strongest! His power is solid and firm and will never, ever weaken or break!

**Example:** *Even the strongest building can break, and the toughest mountain can crumble — but Allah's strength never weakens, not even a tiny bit!*

---

#59  القادر **Al-Qadir**

**The Fully Able**

Allah can do anything! Nothing is too hard for Him and nothing makes Him tired!

**Example:** *If you can't open a jar, you ask someone stronger. But nothing is hard for Allah — He can do EVERYTHING!*

---

#60  القدير **Al-Qadeer**

**The All-Powerful**

Allah has complete and total power over everything. He just says 'Be!' and it happens instantly!

**Example:** *If Allah wants something to happen — like bringing someone back to life or creating a new star — He just says 'Be!' and it is!*

---

#61  المقتدر **Al-Muqtadir**

**The Omnipotent**

Allah has absolute power — nothing is impossible for Him. He can do anything, anytime, anywhere!

**Example:** *People say 'That's impossible!' — but for Allah, NOTHING is impossible. He has power over everything!*

---

#62  الجبار **Al-Jabbaar**

**The Compeller**

Allah is so powerful that everything is under His control and power. But He is also so kind that He fixes the broken hearts of sad people!

**Example:** *If your heart is feeling broken or sad, talk to Al-Jabbaar — He can heal your heart and make you feel better again!*

---

#63  القاهر **Al-Qaahir**

**The Subduer**

Allah is above everyone and everything. No one can go against what He decides!

**Example:** *If Allah decides something will happen, no one in the whole universe can stop it. Not even all the people together!*

---

#64  القهار **Al-Qahhaar**

**The Overpowering**

Allah is the One who overpowers everything. He is in charge and nothing can escape His control!

**Example:** *Even the strongest bully or the most powerful person — they are all weak compared to Allah. He overpowers everyone!*

---

#65  المتكبر **Al-Mutakabbir**

**The Supreme**

Allah alone has the right to be great and above everyone. Only He is truly supreme and magnificent!

**Example:** *When someone acts proud and bossy, that's not nice. But when ALLAH is Supreme, it's perfect — because He really IS the Greatest!*

---

#66  الحليم **Al-Haleem**

**The Forbearing**

Allah is so patient! Even when people make mistakes, He doesn't punish them straight away. He gives them time to say sorry.

**Example:** *Imagine if every time you did something wrong, you got in trouble immediately! But Allah is patient — He gives you time to learn and do better.*

---

#67  الغفار **Al-Ghaffaar**

**The Oft-Forgiving**

Allah forgives you again and again and again! Every time you say sorry and mean it, He forgives you!

**Example:** *Even if you make the same mistake many times but keep coming back to Allah and saying sorry, He keeps forgiving you. He never gets tired of forgiving!*

---

#68  الغفور **Al-Ghafoor**

**The All-Forgiving**

When you say sorry to Allah and really mean it, He forgives you completely — like it never happened!

**Example:** *Imagine writing a mistake in pencil and then erasing it perfectly so you can't even see it anymore. That's how Allah forgives — completely!*

---

#69  العفو **Al-'Afuww**

**The Pardon**

Allah doesn't just forgive — He wipes your sins away completely as if they never happened at all!

**Example:** *It's like writing in the sand and then a big wave comes and washes it away completely. Allah can erase your mistakes just like that!*

---

#70  التواب **At-Tawwaab**

**Acceptor of Repentance**

Allah actually helps you want to say sorry, and then when you do, He happily accepts it! He loves it when you come back to Him!

**Example:** *When you feel in your heart that you want to say sorry to Allah — that feeling itself is from Him! He put it in your heart because He wants to forgive you!*

---

#71  الشهيد **Ash-Shaheed**

**The Witness**

Allah sees and knows everything that happens. He is a witness to every single thing, big or small!

**Example:** *If you do a kind deed when nobody is watching — like helping an animal or picking up litter — Allah saw it all!*

---

#72  المهيمن **Al-Muhaymin**

**The Trustworthy Witness**

Allah watches over everything and everyone. He keeps track of everything and you can always trust Him!

**Example:** *Just like a lifeguard watches over swimmers to keep them safe, Allah watches over the whole world — but He NEVER looks away!*

---

#73  المؤمن **Al-Mu'min**

**Granter of Security**

Allah keeps you safe and secure. He always keeps His promises and He never treats anyone unfairly!

**Example:** *When you feel scared at night, remember Al-Mu'min — Allah is the One who gives you safety and peace. You can always count on Him!*

---

#74  الولي **Al-Waliyy**

**The Guardian Lord**

Allah is the special friend and helper of the believers. He guides them, protects them, and helps them succeed!

**Example:** *When you try your best to be good and pray to Allah, He becomes your Waliyy — your special guardian who takes extra care of you!*

---

#75  المولى **Al-Mawlaa**

**The Patron Lord**

Allah is the ultimate Supporter! He helps the believers especially, and gives them victory over their enemies!

**Example:** *Remember the story of Prophet Moosa when the sea split in two? Allah was his Mawlaa — His supporter — and saved him and all the believers!*

---

#76  الرقيب Ar-Raqeeb

**The Watchful**

Allah is always watching — He never misses a single thing! He knows every thought, every whisper, and every action!

**Example:** *Even when you think nobody is looking, Allah is watching. So when you choose to be honest even when no one sees, Allah notices and is pleased!*

---

#77  الحفيظ Al-Hafeedh

**The Guardian**

Allah guards you from harm and keeps your good deeds safe. He protects the believers from falling into sin too!

**Example:** *Just like how your parents watch over you to keep you safe, Allah is always protecting you, even when you're sleeping!*

---

#78  الحافظ Al-Haafidh

**The Protector**

Allah holds the sky, the earth, and everything together! Without Him, the whole universe would fall apart!

**Example:** *The Earth spins around the sun at just the right speed, the moon stays in its place — Allah is holding it all together perfectly!*

---

#79  المحيط Al-Muheet

**The Encompassing**

Allah surrounds everything with His knowledge and power. Nothing can escape Him or hide from Him!

**Example:** *Imagine a circle that goes around EVERYTHING that exists — every planet, every ocean, every tiny atom. Allah's knowledge surrounds it all!*

---

#80  المقيت Al-Muqteet

**The All-Powerful Maintainer**

Allah takes care of everything and everyone, and He keeps track of it all. He provides and watches over all at the same time!

**Example:** Billions of people, animals, and creatures all need food and care at the same time — and Allah provides for every single one. He never mixes anything up!

---

#81  **الواسع** Al-Waasi'

### The Vast

Allah's mercy, knowledge, and generosity are SO vast — they have no limits! They spread over everything!

**Example:** If you tried to count all of Allah's blessings on just YOU, you could never finish. Now imagine His blessings on the WHOLE world! They're endless!

---

#82  **الصادق** As-Saadiq

### The Truthful

Allah always tells the truth. Everything He says is true — every promise, every word in the Quran, everything!

**Example:** When Allah promises Jannah for good people, you can be 100% sure it's true — because Allah NEVER breaks a promise!

---

#83  **الطيب** At-Tayyib

### The Pure One

Allah is pure and perfect. He is free from any fault or bad quality. Everything about Him is good and beautiful!

**Example:** Allah is At-Tayyib and He loves what is pure and good. That's why when you eat halal food and do good deeds, Allah loves it!

---

#84  **القدوس** Al-Quddoos

### The Pure & Perfect

Allah is absolutely perfect and pure! There is nothing wrong or bad about Him at all. The angels praise Him day and night!

**Example:** When you say 'SubhaanAllah' (Glory be to Allah), you are saying that Allah is free from any imperfection — He is perfect in every way!

---

#85  السلام **As-Salaam**

**The Flawless**

Allah is free from all faults and flaws. He spreads peace and safety, and He will never be unfair to anyone!

**Example:** When you say 'Assalaamu Alaikum,' you are spreading peace — and that word 'Salaam' comes from this beautiful Name of Allah!

---

#86  السبوح **As-Subbooh**

**The Venerated**

Allah is praised and glorified by the angels all the time. He is free from every imperfection!

**Example:** Right now, at this very moment, millions of angels are saying 'SubhaanAllah' — glorifying and praising Allah without stopping!

---

#87  المجيد **Al-Majeed**

**The Glorious**

Allah is full of glory and splendor! He is honored and majestic, and His glory shines in everything He does!

**Example:** When you send salawaat on the Prophet, you say 'Innaka Hameedum-Majeed' — You are Praiseworthy and Glorious! That's Allah's glory!

---

#88  الحميد **Al-Hameed**

**The Praiseworthy**

Allah deserves all the praise! Everything good comes from Him, and He should be thanked and praised always!

**Example:** When you say 'Alhamdulillah' after eating, sneezing, or anytime something good happens — you are praising Al-Hameed, the Praiseworthy!

---

#89  الشاكر **Ash-Shaakir**

**The Appreciative**

Allah appreciates even the smallest good thing you do! A tiny deed can get a HUGE reward from Him!

**Example:** Even if you smile at someone or move something harmful off the road, Allah appreciates it and rewards you for it! No good deed is too small!

---

#90  الشكور Ash-Shakoor

**The Most Appreciative**

Allah multiplies your rewards many, many times! He makes sure that no good deed you ever did is lost or wasted!

**Example:** *If you give just one date in charity, Allah can turn that into a mountain of rewards on the Day of Judgement! He is the Most Appreciative!*

---

#91  الحسيب Al-Haseeb

**The Reckoner**

Allah keeps count of everything you do and will account for it all. He also takes care of all your needs!

**Example:** *If you trust Allah and say 'HasbiyAllah' (Allah is enough for me), He will take care of all your worries and problems!*

---

#92  الحق Al-Haqq

**The Truth**

Allah is the Truth — He is real, He truly exists, and everything He says and does is completely true!

**Example:** *Some things in stories are made up, but Allah is REAL. He is the most real thing that exists — the absolute Truth!*

---

#93  المبين Al-Mubeen

**The Manifest**

Allah's existence and right to be worshiped is clear and obvious. The signs of Allah are everywhere!

**Example:** *Look at the sun, the moon, the mountains, and the oceans — they all make it clear that an amazing Creator made them. That's Al-Mubeen!*

---

#94  الوكيل Al-Wakeel

**The Trustee**

You can always depend on Allah. When you put your trust in Him, He takes care of everything for you!

**Example:** Before you leave the house, say 'Tawakkaltu 'alAllaah' — I put my trust in Allah. He will be your guardian and take care of your day!

---

#95  **المقدم** Al-Muqaddim

**The Advancer**

Allah puts things first when they should come first. He advances whoever He wills with His perfect wisdom!

**Example:** Sometimes one student gets picked for something special before others — Allah decides who gets what and when, based on His perfect plan!

---

#96  **المؤخر** Al-Mu'akhkhir

**The Delayer**

Allah delays things when it's wise to delay them. If something hasn't happened yet, Allah has a perfect reason for the timing!

**Example:** If you made dua and it hasn't been answered yet, don't worry! Allah might be delaying it because something even BETTER is coming!

---

#97  **القريب** Al-Qareeb

**The Near**

Allah is close to you — really close! He is near to everyone who calls on Him and turns to Him!

**Example:** You don't need to shout for Allah to hear you. He is closer to you than you think! Even a tiny whisper in your heart reaches Him!

---

#98  **المجيب** Al-Mujeeb

**The Responsive**

When you call on Allah, He answers you! He responds to every person who makes dua to Him!

**Example:** When you raise your hands and ask Allah for something — He hears it right away and responds! Maybe now, maybe later, but He always responds!

---

#99  **الشافى** Ash-Shaafee

## The Healer

Allah is the One who heals you when you are sick. All cures and healing come from Him!

**Example:** *When you have a cold and you take medicine and get better — the medicine is just a tool, but the real healing came from Allah, Ash-Shaafee!*

---

## #100 الكافي Al-Kafi

### The Sufficient

Allah is enough for you! You don't need anyone else if you have Allah. He is sufficient for everything!

**Example:** *If you ever feel like you can't handle something, remember Al-Kafi — Allah is enough! With Him on your side, you have everything you need!*

---

## #101 النصير An-Naseer

### The Helper

Allah helps and supports the believers. He is the best helper you could ever have!

**Example:** *Remember when the Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) and Abu Bakr were hiding in the cave? Allah helped them and kept them safe. He is the best Helper!*

---

## #102 الوارث Al-Waarith

### The Inheritor

After everything in this world is gone, Allah will remain. Everything belongs to Him in the end!

**Example:** *Toys break, buildings fall, and even mountains will crumble one day. But Allah will still be there — He inherits everything!*

---

## #103 الجميل Al-Jameel

### The Beautiful

Allah is the most Beautiful! His Names are beautiful, His actions are beautiful, and He is the source of all beauty!

**Example:** *A stunning sunset, a beautiful rainbow, a field of flowers — all that beauty comes from Allah, and He is even MORE beautiful than all of it!*

---

#104  المحسن Al-Muhsin

**The Doer of Good**

Everything Allah does is done perfectly and beautifully. He is the Doer of Good, and He loves people who do good too!

**Example:** *When you try your best to do something really well — like writing neatly or being extra kind — you are following the way of Al-Muhsin!*

---

#105  السّيتّر As-Sitteer

**The Concealer of Sins**

Allah covers your mistakes and sins so that other people don't see them. He protects your secrets!

**Example:** *If you did something wrong and felt embarrassed, Allah can hide it from everyone so nobody finds out. He lovingly covers your faults!*

---

#106  الدّيّان Ad-Dayyaan

**The Supreme Judge**

Allah will reward everyone for what they did — good or bad. On the Day of Judgement, He will be the Supreme Judge!

**Example:** *Every good deed you ever did — even ones you forgot about — Allah kept count and will reward you for all of them!*

---

#107  ذو الجلال والإكرام Dhul-Jalaali wal-Ikraam

**Possessor of Majesty & Honor**

Allah is full of greatness and generosity! He deserves to be honored and glorified because He is truly magnificent!

**Example:** *The Prophet (peace be upon him) told us to keep saying 'Yaa Dhal-Jalaali wal-Ikraam' — because Allah loves being called by this grand, beautiful Name!*

## Part 3

# Spot the Difference!

Many of Allah's Names sound similar — but each one is special! Let's find out what makes them different.

### 1. Oneness & Uniqueness

These Names all tell us that Allah is ONE — but each one says it in a slightly different way!

🙏 الإله Al-Ilaah — *The One Worthy of Worship*

💎 الأحَد Al-Ahad — *The Unique*

👉 الواحد Al-Waahid — *The One and Only*

1️⃣ الوتر Al-Witr — *The Single*

**What's the difference?** Al-Ahad means He is unique (nothing is even similar to Him). Al-Waahid means He is One in number (no partner). Al-Witr means He is Single and does everything alone. Think of it like this: Al-Ahad = nobody is LIKE Him, Al-Waahid = nobody is WITH Him, Al-Witr = nobody HELPS Him!



### 2. Mercy, Kindness & Compassion

Allah has SO many Names about mercy and kindness! But each one is special.

💖 الرحمن Ar-Rahmaan — *The Most Merciful*

👉 الرحيم Ar-Raheem — *The Bestower of Mercy*

💖 الودود Al-Wadood — *The Loving One*

🌸 البر Al-Barr — *The Most Kind*

🩹 الرؤوف Ar-Ra'oof — *The Compassionate*

👂 الحفي Al-Hafiy — *The Benevolent*

👉 الرفيق Ar-Rafeeq — *The Gentle*

**What's the difference?** Ar-Rahmaan = His mercy is HUGE and covers everything (like the sky covers the earth). Ar-Raheem = He actively shows mercy to you personally. Al-Wadood = He LOVES you! **What's the difference?** Al-Akram = He is THE most generous (nobody can out-give Him). Al-Kareem = He gives even to those who don't thank Him. Al-Jawaad = His giving is like a never-ending ocean. Al-Wahhaab = He gives gifts freely, without being asked. Al-Mannaan = Every blessing you have started with Him. Ar-Razzaaq = He provides food, water, and everything you need!



## 4. Withholding, Giving & Preventing

*A du'a for every Name, plus a tip on how to live by it every day!*

### #1 الله **Allaah** — *The God*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Allaah, I ask You by every Name that belongs to You to forgive me and have mercy on me.*

**How to live by it:** Begin every important matter with "Bismillaah." Make Allaah the center of your life — consult His guidance before decisions, remember Him in ease and hardship, and make your purpose in life seeking...

**Quran:** *Mentioned over 2,600 times in the Quran. "Allaah — there is no deity except Him, the Ever-Living, the Self-Sustaining." (Al-Baqarah 2:255)*

### #2 الرب **Ar-Rabb** — *The Lord & Nurturer*

**Du'a:** *Rabbanaa aatinaa fid-dunyaa hasanah, wa fil-aakhirati hasanah, wa qinaa 'adhaab an-naar. (Our Lord, give us good in this world and good in the Hereafter and protect us from the Fire.)*

**How to live by it:** Recognize that every blessing is from your Rabb nurturing you. Accept His tarbiyah (nurturing) even when it comes through tests and trials, knowing He is raising you toward something better.

**Quran:** *"All praise is due to Allaah, Rabb of all the worlds." (Al-Faatihah 1:2). "Our Lord, we have wronged ourselves." (Al-A'raaf 7:23)*

### #3 الإله **Al-Ilaah** — *The One Worthy of Worship*

**Du'a:** *Laa ilaaha illaa Anta, Subhaanaka innee kuntu minath-thaalimeen. (There is no deity except You; glory be to You. Indeed, I have been of the wrongdoers.)*

**How to live by it:** Direct every act of worship — your prayers, your hopes, your fears, your love — exclusively to Him. Check your heart for any attachment that competes with Him and work to purify it.

**Quran:** *"And your Ilaah is one Ilaah. There is no deity except Him, the Most Merciful, the Especially Merciful." (Al-Baqarah 2:163)*

### #4 الأحد **Al-Ahad** — *The Unique*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Ahad, Yaa Samad, I ask You as the One Who is uniquely One, to fulfill my need, for there is none like You.*

**How to live by it:** Internalize tawheed (monotheism) in every dimension of your life. Never equate anything with Allaah in love, fear, hope, or reliance. He is unique — treat Him as such in your heart.

**Quran:** *"Say: He is Allaah, Al-Ahad." (Al-Ikhlaas 112:1)*

### #5 الواحد **Al-Waahid** — *The One and Only*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Waahid, unite my heart upon Your obedience and do not let me divide my devotion between You and anything else.*

**How to live by it:** Unify your heart's devotion. Do not let worldly distractions split your focus. Make your relationship with the One God the single most important relationship in your life.

**Quran:** *"Your God is One God; there is no deity except Him." (Al-Baqarah 2:163). "Say: I am only a warner, and there is no deity except Allaah, the One, th..."*

### #6 الوتر **Al-Witr** — *The Single*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Witr, You are One without any partner. I ask You alone, for there is no helper besides You.*

**How to live by it:** Pray the Witr prayer consistently, as it is beloved to Al-Witr. Let the singleness of Allaah inspire you to be single-minded in your devotion and not scatter your worship.

**Quran:** *Implied in Surah Al-Ikhlaas and in verses affirming His absolute oneness without partner.*

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## #7 ⌚ **الأول Al-Awwal — The First**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Awwal, You were before all things. Put me first in goodness and make me among the foremost in faith.*

**How to live by it:** Put Allaah first in your day, your plans, and your priorities. Begin your mornings with remembrance of Him, and make His commands the first thing you consider before any decision.

**Quran:** *"He is Al-Awwal (the First) and Al-Aakhir (the Last), and Adh-Dhaahir (the Uppermost) and Al-Baatin (the Innermost), and He is, of all things, Know..."*

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## #8 ∞ **الأخر Al-Aakhir — The Last**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Aakhir, You remain when all else perishes. Let my final deeds be my best deeds, and let my last words be Laa ilaaha illAllaah.*

**How to live by it:** Remember that everything in this world is temporary and will end, but your Lord remains forever. Invest in what lasts — your relationship with Al-Aakhir and the deeds you send forward for the Herea...

**Quran:** *"He is Al-Awwal and Al-Aakhir." (Al-Hadeed 57:3)*

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## #9 ↑ **الظاهر Adh-Dhaahir — The Uppermost**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Dhaahir, nothing is above You. Elevate my rank and raise me above my sins and shortcomings.*

**How to live by it:** Look at the signs of Allaah that are apparent all around you — in the sky, the mountains, the oceans. Reflect on how His existence is manifest in everything you see, strengthening your certainty.

**Quran:** *"He is Al-Awwal and Al-Aakhir and Adh-Dhaahir and Al-Baatin." (Al-Hadeed 57:3)*

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## #10 🧠 **الباطن Al-Baatin — The Innermost**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Baatin, You know my innermost secrets. Purify what is hidden in my heart and make my private life better than my public life.*

**How to live by it:** Be mindful that Allaah knows your innermost thoughts. Strive to make your inner state as good as your outer state, for Al-Baatin sees what no one else can see.

**Quran:** *"He is Al-Awwal and Al-Aakhir and Adh-Dhaahir and Al-Baatin, and He is of all things Knowing." (Al-Hadeed 57:3)*

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## #11 ❤️ **الرحمن Ar-Rahmaan — The Most Merciful**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Rahmaan, envelop me in Your vast mercy and do not deprive me of it, for Your mercy encompasses all things.*

**How to live by it:** Never despair of Allaah's mercy, no matter how great your sins. Show mercy to others — be merciful to your family, your neighbors, animals, and even those who wrong you. The merciful are shown merc...

**Quran:** *"The Most Merciful (Ar-Rahmaan), taught the Quran, created man." (Ar-Rahmaan 55:1-3). Mentioned 57 times in the Quran.*

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## #12 📖 **الرحيم Ar-Raheem — The Bestower of Mercy**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Raheem, bestow Your special mercy upon me and guide me to what pleases You, for I am in need of Your mercy.*

**How to live by it:** Be a means of delivering Allaah's mercy to others. When you feed the hungry, comfort the distressed, or help the needy, you become a channel through which Ar-Raheem's mercy reaches His servants.

**Quran:** "And He is, to the believers, Raheem (Merciful)." (Al-Ahzaab 33:43). Found in every Bismillaah.

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### #13 **الودود Al-Wadood — The Loving One**

**Du'a:** Yaa Wadood, fill my heart with love for You and make me among those whom You love. Place love for me in the hearts of Your righteous servants.

**How to live by it:** Seek Allaah's love by following the Prophet (ﷺ), doing voluntary good deeds, and drawing closer through extra prayers and remembrance. Show love to Allaah's creation as a reflection of your love for...

**Quran:** "And He is the Forgiving, the Loving (Al-Wadood)." (Al-Burooj 85:14). "And ask forgiveness of your Lord and then repent to Him. Indeed, my Lord is ..."

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### #14 **البر Al-Barr — The Most Kind**

**Du'a:** Yaa Barr, treat me with Your beautiful kindness and rectify all my affairs, for You are the source of all goodness.

**How to live by it:** Be kind to your parents (birrul-waalidayn), as this is the human reflection of Al-Barr's kindness. Treat people well even when they treat you poorly, remembering that Al-Barr is kind even to those ...

**Quran:** "Indeed, we used to supplicate Him before. Indeed, it is He who is Al-Barr (the Kind), the Merciful." (At-Toor 52:28)

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### #15 **الرؤوف Ar-Ra'oof — The Compassionate**

**Du'a:** Yaa Ra'oof, be gentle with me in Your decree and do not burden me with what I cannot bear. Show me Your compassion in this difficulty.

**How to live by it:** Be compassionate to those weaker than you — children, the elderly, animals, the poor. Show gentleness in your speech and actions, as Ar-Ra'oof loves compassion in His servants.

**Quran:** "Indeed Allaah, to the people, is Ra'oof (Kind/Compassionate) and Raheem (Merciful)." (Al-Baqarah 2:143)

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### #16 **الحي Al-Hafiy — The Benevolent**

**Du'a:** Yaa Hafiy, You have always been kind to me. Continue to respond to my supplications and do not turn me away.

**How to live by it:** Be consistent in your du'aa, knowing that Al-Hafiy loves to be asked and is ever-kind in responding. Never stop making du'aa, even if the answer seems delayed.

**Quran:** "Indeed, He is ever to me Al-Hafiy (gracious/benevolent)." (Maryam 19:47 — Ibraaheem's words about his Lord)

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### #17 **الرفيق Ar-Rafeeq — The Gentle**

**Du'a:** Yaa Rafeeq, be gentle with me in my affairs and grant me gentleness in dealing with Your creation.

**How to live by it:** Practice gentleness in everything — in your speech, your parenting, your teaching, and your dealings. Harshness drives people away, while gentleness draws them close, both to you and to Allaah.

**Quran:** This Name is established through the Sunnah rather than a direct Quranic mention, though the concept of Allaah's gentleness pervades the Quran.

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### #18 **الأكرم Al-Akram — The Most Generous**

**Du'a:** Yaa Akram, You are the Most Generous. I ask You from Your vast generosity to grant me what I cannot even imagine for myself.

**How to live by it:** Be generous with your wealth, time, knowledge, and kind words. The more generous you are for Allaah's sake, the more Al-Akram will give you. Never fear poverty from giving.

**Quran:** "Read! And your Lord is Al-Akram (the Most Generous)." (Al-'Alaq 96:3)

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### #19 **الكريم Al-Kareem — The Bountiful**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Kareem, You give even to those who disobey You. Do not deprive me of Your generosity, and forgive my sins with Your noble pardoning.*

**How to live by it:** When you see people sinning yet still blessed by Allaah, know it is from His karam (generosity). Do not mistake it for approval; rather, use it as motivation to thank Him and return to Him.

**Quran:** "O mankind, what has deceived you concerning your Lord, Al-Kareem (the Generous)?" (Al-Infitaar 82:6)

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### #20 **الجواد Al-Jawaad — The Munificent**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Jawaad, Your generosity covers everything. Pour upon me from Your boundless giving and make me content with what You provide.*

**How to live by it:** Give freely without calculating returns, as Al-Jawaad gives without expecting compensation. The more you give, the more He gives you. Generosity attracts generosity.

**Quran:** *The concept is affirmed throughout the Quran in verses about Allaah's limitless giving and generosity to all of creation.*

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### #21 **القابض Al-Qaabid — The Withholder**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Qaabid, if You have withheld something from me, I trust it is for my good. Grant me patience and replace it with something better.*

**How to live by it:** When something you wanted is withheld from you, do not despair. Trust that Al-Qaabid knows what is harmful and what is beneficial. Practice patience when provision feels tight.

**Quran:** "Allaah extends (yabsut) provision for whom He wills and restricts (yaqdiru) it." (Ar-Ra'd 13:26)

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### #22 **الباسط Al-Baasit — The Expander**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Baasit, expand my provision, expand my chest with faith, and expand for me every good in this world and the next.*

**How to live by it:** When Allaah expands your provision, increase in gratitude and generosity. Share your blessings, for hoarding invites constriction while sharing invites more expansion from Al-Baasit.

**Quran:** "Allaah extends (yabsut) provision for whom He wills." (Al-Baqarah 2:245)

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### #23 **المانع Al-Mani' — The Preventer**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Mani', prevent from me every evil and every harm, and protect me from the evil of my own self.*

**How to live by it:** Accept what is prevented from you with grace. Sometimes Allaah prevents something you desperately want because He can see the harm in it that you cannot. Trust His prevention as you trust His giving.

**Quran:** *The concept is found in: "Whatever Allaah grants to people of mercy, none can withhold it; and whatever He withholds, none can release it." (Faatir...*

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### #24 **المعطي Al-Mu'tee — The Giver**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Mu'tee, give me what is good for my religion, my worldly life, and my Hereafter, and withhold from me what is harmful.*

**How to live by it:** When you receive a blessing, acknowledge it is from Al-Mu'tee and express gratitude. When you see others receive, do not envy them — Al-Mu'tee gives to each what is fitting.

**Quran:** *Implied in numerous verses: "Whatever Allaah grants to people of mercy, none can withhold." (Faatir 35:2)*

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## #25 الوهاب **Al-Wahhaab — The Bestower**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Wahhaab, grant me from Your treasures what will benefit me in this life and the next, and bestow upon me guidance and firmness.*

**How to live by it:** Ask Allaah frequently using this Name, especially for non-material gifts: guidance, a sound heart, beneficial knowledge, and righteous offspring. Al-Wahhaab gives freely — so ask freely.

**Quran:** *"Our Lord, let not our hearts deviate after You have guided us, and grant us from Yourself mercy. Indeed, You are Al-Wahhaab (the Bestower)." (Aal-...*

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## #26 المنان **Al-Mannaan — The Beneficent Bestower**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Mannaan, You are the source of every blessing I have. I thank You for Your countless favors and ask You for more from Your bounty.*

**How to live by it:** Count your blessings regularly. Keep a gratitude practice where you acknowledge the favors of Al-Mannaan. The more you count, the more you realize how much He has given you.

**Quran:** *The concept is in: "And if you should count the favors of Allaah, you could not enumerate them." (An-Nahl 16:18)*

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## #27 الرزاق **Ar-Razzaaq — The Great Provider**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Razzaaq, provide for me halaal sustenance that is abundant and blessed, and nourish my heart with eemaan and knowledge.*

**How to live by it:** Trust in your provision and do not compromise your deen for wealth. Take the means but rely on Ar-Razzaaq. Work honestly and leave the results to Him.

**Quran:** *"Indeed, Allaah is Ar-Razzaaq, Possessor of Power, the Strong." (Adh-Dhaariyaat 51:58)*

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## #28 الرازق **Ar-Raaziq — The Sustainer**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Raaziq, sustain me and my family with wholesome provision and bless what You have given us.*

**How to live by it:** Never be anxious about your rizq. It has been written and guaranteed. Focus instead on making your rizq halaal and blessed, and Ar-Raaziq will take care of the rest.

**Quran:** *"And there is no creature on earth but that upon Allaah is its provision." (Hood 11:6)*

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## #29 اللطيف **Al-Lateef — The Subtle & Kind**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Lateef, be gentle with me in Your decree. Bring me good from where I do not expect it, and avert harm from me in ways I cannot see.*

**How to live by it:** When you look back at your life and see how difficulties led to blessings, that is the work of Al-Lateef. Trust that even now, He is working behind the scenes for your benefit.

**Quran:** *"Allaah is Lateef (Subtle/Kind) with His servants." (Ash-Shooraa 42:19). "Indeed, my Lord is Lateef to what He wills." (Yoosuf 12:100)*

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## #30 الحبي **Al-Hayiyy — The Honorably Shy**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Hayiyy, You are too generous to turn me away. I raise my hands to You — please do not return them empty.*

**How to live by it:** Always raise your hands in du'aa with full confidence that Al-Hayiy will not leave you empty-handed. Also, cultivate hayaa' (modesty) in yourself, especially when tempted to sin while alone.

**Quran:** *The concept is reflected in verses about Allaah's generosity and His never turning away those who ask.*

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### #31 الحي Al-Hayy — *The Ever-Living*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Hayy, Yaa Qayyoom, bi rahmatika astagheeth. (O Ever-Living, O Self-Sustaining, by Your mercy I seek help.)*

**How to live by it:** Attach your heart to the Ever-Living Who never dies, rather than to mortals who will perish. When you lose someone you love, remember that Al-Hayy remains and His companionship never ends.

**Quran:** *"Allaah — there is no deity except Him, Al-Hayy (the Ever-Living), Al-Qayyoom (the Self-Sustaining)." (Al-Baqarah 2:255 — Aayatul-Kursiyy)*

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### #32 القيوم Al-Qayyoom — *The Self-Sustaining*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Qayyoom, You sustain everything. Sustain my heart with faith and sustain my life with Your blessings.*

**How to live by it:** Rely on Al-Qayyoom completely. He does not sleep, does not forget, and does not neglect. Whatever you need, He is already sustaining you. Recite Aayatul-Kursiyy often, reflecting on these Names.

**Quran:** *"Allaah — there is no deity except Him, Al-Hayy, Al-Qayyoom. Neither drowsiness overtakes Him nor sleep." (Al-Baqarah 2:255)*

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### #33 الصمد As-Samad — *The Eternal Lord*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Samad, I turn to You as the One upon Whom all depend. Fulfill my needs, for I have no one to turn to but You.*

**How to live by it:** When everyone else fails you, remember that As-Samad never fails. Reduce your dependence on people and increase your dependence on the One Who is free of all needs and upon Whom all depend.

**Quran:** *"Allaah, As-Samad." (Al-Ikhlaas 112:2)*

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### #34 الغني Al-Ghaniyy — *The Self-Sufficient*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Ghaniyy, enrich me with Your bounty and free me from dependence on anyone other than You.*

**How to live by it:** Acknowledge your total need for Allaah and His total independence from you. This is the foundation of true humility. Give charity freely, knowing that Al-Ghaniyy does not need your wealth — but you...

**Quran:** *"O mankind, you are those in need of Allaah, while Allaah is Al-Ghaniyy (the Free of need), the Praiseworthy." (Faatir 35:15)*

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### #35 الخالق Al-Khaaliq — *The Creator*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Khaaliq, You created me from nothing. Perfect Your creation in me and guide me to fulfill the purpose for which You created me.*

**How to live by it:** Reflect on the creation around you as signs of Al-Khaaliq. Study nature, the human body, the cosmos — each is a masterpiece pointing to the Creator. Let this reflection increase your faith and humi...

**Quran:** *"He is Allaah, Al-Khaaliq (the Creator), Al-Baari' (the Originator), Al-Musawwir (the Fashioner)." (Al-Hashr 59:24)*

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### #36 الخلاق Al-Khallaq — *The Constant Creator*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Khallaq, create goodness in my life, create ease after my hardship, and recreate me on the Day of Judgment in the best form.*

**How to live by it:** When you feel stuck, remember that Al-Khallaq creates new beginnings constantly. No situation is permanent, and He can create a way out from where you least expect it.

**Quran:** "Indeed, your Lord — He is Al-Khallaq (the Knowing Creator)." (Al-Hijr 15:86)

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### #37 الباري Al-Baari' — The Originator

**Du'a:** *Yaa Baari', You originated me without any example. Make me an original force for good and do not let me be a copy of those who go astray.*

**How to live by it:** Appreciate your uniqueness. Al-Baari' made you an original — your appearance, your abilities, your circumstances. Do not waste time wishing to be someone else; instead, fulfill the unique purpose H...

**Quran:** "He is Allaah, Al-Khaaliq, Al-Baari', Al-Musawwir." (Al-Hashr 59:24)

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### #38 المصور Al-Musawwir — The Fashioner of Forms

**Du'a:** *Yaa Musawwir, You fashioned me in the best of forms. Let my inner form (character) match the beauty of Your outward design.*

**How to live by it:** Accept your physical form with gratitude, for Al-Musawwir chose it for you with wisdom. Focus on beautifying your character and deeds, which are the inner form that matters most.

**Quran:** "He is Allaah, Al-Khaaliq, Al-Baari', Al-Musawwir. To Him belong the most beautiful Names." (Al-Hashr 59:24)

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### #39 الهادي Al-Haadi — The Guide

**Du'a:** *Yaa Haadi, guide me to the straight path, guide my heart to the truth, and do not let me go astray after You have guided me.*

**How to live by it:** Ask for guidance in every salah (Ihdinas-siraatal-mustaqeem) with full presence of heart. Be a source of guidance for others by sharing beneficial knowledge and being a good example.

**Quran:** "And sufficient is your Lord as a Guide (Haadi) and a Helper." (Al-Furqaan 25:31). "Indeed, you do not guide whom you like, but Allaah guides whom ..."

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### #40 الفتح Al-Fattaah — The Opener & Judge

**Du'a:** *Yaa Fattaah, open for me doors of goodness and provision, and open my heart to understand Your religion.*

**How to live by it:** When you feel that all doors are closed, call upon Al-Fattaah. He opens doors that seemed permanently shut. Pray Salatul-Istikhaarah before major decisions, asking Al-Fattaah to open the best path.

**Quran:** "Say: Our Lord will bring us together, then He will judge (yaftah) between us in truth. And He is Al-Fattaah, the Knowing." (Saba' 34:26)

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### #41 الحكم Al-Hakam — The Judge

**Du'a:** *Yaa Hakam, judge between me and those who have wronged me with Your perfect justice, and do not hold me accountable for what I did unknowingly.*

**How to live by it:** Accept Allaah's rulings in His Sharee'ah, even when you do not fully understand the wisdom. Trust that Al-Hakam's judgments are always just and wise, even when they are difficult to bear.

**Quran:** "Shall I seek other than Allaah as judge (hakam)?" (Al-An'aam 6:114)

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### #42 الحكيم Al-Hakeem — The All-Wise

**Du'a:** *Yaa Hakeem, grant me wisdom in my speech and actions, and help me see Your wisdom in everything that happens to me.*

**How to live by it:** When something happens that you cannot understand, say "Allaah is Al-Hakeem" and trust that there is wisdom you cannot yet see. Study the Quran deeply, for it is the Book of Al-Hakeem.

**Quran:** "And Allaah is Mighty and Wise (Hakeem)." (Al-Baqarah 2:228). Mentioned over 90 times in the Quran.

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#43  **العليم Al-'Aleem — The All-Knowing**

**Du'a:** Yaa 'Aleem, You know what I need before I ask. Grant me what is best for me, even if I do not know what that is.

**How to live by it:** Be humble about your own knowledge, recognizing that human knowledge is a tiny drop compared to Al-'Aleem's ocean. Seek beneficial knowledge throughout your life, as it brings you closer to the All...

**Quran:** "Allaah is the All-Knowing ('Aleem) of everything." (At-Taghaabun 64:11). Mentioned over 150 times in the Quran.

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#44  **العالم Al-'Aalim — Knower of Seen & Unseen**

**Du'a:** Yaa 'Aalim al-Ghayb, You know what is hidden from me. Protect me from unseen harms and guide me to unseen blessings.

**How to live by it:** Remember that there is an entire unseen world — angels, destiny, the Hereafter — that Al-'Aalim knows perfectly. Let this strengthen your belief in matters of the ghayb.

**Quran:** "'Aalim (Knower) of the unseen and the witnessed, the Grand, the Exalted." (Ar-Ra'd 13:9)

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#45  **الخبير Al-Khabeer — The Fully Aware**

**Du'a:** Yaa Khabeer, You are fully aware of my condition. You know my struggles, my efforts, and my intentions. Help me according to what You know of me.

**How to live by it:** Know that Al-Khabeer sees your efforts even when no one else does. Your silent struggles, private tears, and unseen sacrifices are all fully known to Him. Let this motivate you during difficult times.

**Quran:** "Indeed, Allaah is Knowing (of what you do) and Aware (Khabeer)." (Al-Hujuraat 49:13)

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#46  **السميع As-Samee' — The All-Hearing**

**Du'a:** Yaa Samee', You hear every prayer I make. Accept my du'aa and respond to my call, for You hear all things.

**How to live by it:** Guard your tongue, knowing that As-Samee' hears everything you say. Speak good or remain silent. Also, supplicate with confidence that even your whispered prayer is heard clearly.

**Quran:** "There is nothing like unto Him, and He is As-Samee' (the All-Hearing), Al-Baseer (the All-Seeing)." (Ash-Shooraa 42:11)

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#47  **البصير Al-Baseer — The All-Seeing**

**Du'a:** Yaa Baseer, You see everything I do. Help me to act as though I see You, and purify my actions from hypocrisy.

**How to live by it:** Practice muraaqabah — the awareness that Al-Baseer is watching. This awareness improves the quality of your worship and deters you from sins committed in private.

**Quran:** "Allaah is Al-Baseer of what you do." (Al-Hujuraat 49:18). "Is not Allaah sufficient for His servant? — and He is Al-Baseer." (Az-Zumar 39:36)

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#48  **الأعلى Al-A'laa — The Most High**

**Du'a:** Yaa A'laa, You are the Most High. Elevate me in knowledge, in eemaan, and in closeness to You.

**How to live by it:** Say "Subhaana Rabbiyal-A'laa" in your sujood with full consciousness. The more you prostrate, the closer you are to the Most High — the lowest physical position brings you to the highest spiritual ...

**Quran:** "Glorify the Name of your Lord, Al-A'laa (the Most High)." (Al-A'laa 87:1)

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### #49 العلي Al-'Aliyy — The Exalted

**Du'a:** *Yaa 'Aliyy, You are exalted above all things. Exalt Your religion and exalt those who strive for it.*

**How to live by it:** Keep your aspirations high and your character elevated. Do not lower yourself to petty disputes or base behavior. Seek the highness that Al-'Aliyy loves: highness of character and faith.

**Quran:** "He is Al-'Aliyy (the Exalted), Al-'Adheem (the Tremendous)." (Al-Baqarah 2:255 — Aayatul-Kursiyy)

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### #50 المتعالي Al-Muta'aalee — The Supremely Exalted

**Du'a:** *Yaa Muta'aalee, You are far above all imperfection. Free me from the lowliness of sin and raise me to the heights of Your obedience.*

**How to live by it:** Never attribute any imperfection or deficiency to Allaah. When you hear false claims about Him, know that Al-Muta'aalee is far above them all. Defend His honor in your heart and speech.

**Quran:** "Aalim of the unseen and the witnessed, the Grand, Al-Muta'aal (the Exalted)." (Ar-Ra'd 13:9)

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### #51 الملك Al-Malik — The King

**Du'a:** *Yaa Malik, You are the King of all kings. Make me among the people of Your kingdom in Jannah, and do not humiliate me on the Day You gather the creation.*

**How to live by it:** Humble yourself before the true King. Whatever authority or position you hold in this world is temporary and delegated. Use any power you have justly, remembering that Al-Malik is watching.

**Quran:** "Say: O Allaah, Maalik al-Mulk (Owner of Sovereignty)." (Aal-'Imraan 3:26). "The Sovereign (Al-Malik), the Pure, the Flawless." (Al-Hashr 59:23)

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### #52 المليك Al-Maleek — The Omnipotent Sovereign

**Du'a:** *Yaa Maleek, grant me a seat of honor near You in Paradise, and make me worthy of Your noble company.*

**How to live by it:** Strive for the ultimate goal: being near Al-Maleek in Paradise. Let this vision motivate you through every hardship and temptation in this world.

**Quran:** "Indeed, the righteous will be among gardens and rivers, in a seat of honor near a Sovereign, Perfect in Ability (Maleek Muqtadir)." (Al-Qamar 54:5...)

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### #53 السيد As-Sayyid — The Lord & Master

**Du'a:** *Yaa Sayyid, You are the Master of all. I am Your servant; treat me with the kindness a master shows to a loyal servant.*

**How to live by it:** Live as a true servant ('abd) of Allaah. The greatest honor is to be called 'AbdAllaah (servant of Allaah). Embrace servitude to As-Sayyid, for in serving Him lies true freedom.

**Quran:** The concept is affirmed in the Quran through the word Rabb (Lord/Master) and through verses affirming that all creation are His servants.

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### #54 الكبير Al-Kabeer — The Greatest

**Du'a:** *Yaa Kabeer, You are greater than every problem I face. No difficulty is too great for You. Help me overcome what overwhelms me.*

**How to live by it:** Say "Allaahu Akbar" with full awareness of its meaning. Whatever you fear, whatever overwhelms you, whatever seems too big — Allaah is greater. Let this takbeer shrink every worldly concern in your...

**Quran:** "That is because Allaah is the Truth, and that what they call upon other than Him is falsehood, and because Allaah is Al-'Aliyy (the Most High), Al..."

#55  العظیم **Al-'Adheem — The Tremendous**

**Du'a:** *Yaa 'Adheem, Your greatness is beyond comprehension. Forgive my tremendous sins with Your tremendous mercy.*

**How to live by it:** Say "Subhaana Rabbiyal-'Adheem" in rukoo' with reflection on His greatness. When your problems feel enormous, remember they are insignificant before Al-'Adheem.

**Quran:** "And He is Al-'Aliyy, Al-'Adheem." (Al-Baqarah 2:255)

#56  العزیز **Al-'Azeez — The Almighty**

**Du'a:** *Yaa 'Azeez, honor me with obedience to You and do not humiliate me with disobedience. Grant me honor through Your religion.*

**How to live by it:** Seek honor only from Al-'Azeez — not from wealth, status, or people's approval. True izzah comes from obedience to Him. Whoever seeks honor from other than Allaah will be humiliated.

**Quran:** "And He is Al-'Azeez (the Almighty), Al-Hakeem (the All-Wise)." Mentioned over 90 times in the Quran, often paired with Al-Hakeem.

#57  القوی **Al-Qawiyy — The Perfect in Strength**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Qawiyy, strengthen me against my nafs and against the enemies of Your religion. Grant me strength in worship and in character.*

**How to live by it:** Be strong in your faith — not aggressive, but firm and unwavering. Build physical, mental, and spiritual strength, as Al-Qawiyy loves strength in His servants when it is used for good.

**Quran:** "Indeed, Allaah is Al-Qawiyy (the Powerful), Al-'Azeez (the Almighty)." (Al-Hajj 22:40)

#58  المتین **Al-Mateen — The Strong**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Mateen, make my faith firm and my resolve unshakeable. Do not let trials weaken my connection to You.*

**How to live by it:** Be firm and consistent in your worship. Do not let trials shake your faith or cause you to abandon your principles. Al-Mateen's strength is firm — let your faith reflect that quality.

**Quran:** "Indeed, it is Allaah who is Ar-Razzaaq, the Firm Possessor of Strength (Dhul-Quwwatil-Mateen)." (Adh-Dhaariyaat 51:58)

#59  القادر **Al-Qaadir — The Fully Able**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Qaadir, You are able to do all things. Change my condition to what is better and grant me what seems impossible.*

**How to live by it:** Never say "this is impossible" about anything you are asking from Allaah. He is Al-Qaadir — nothing is beyond His ability. Let this free you from hopelessness.

**Quran:** "Is not He Who created the heavens and the earth Able (Qaadir) to create the likes of them?" (Yaaseen 36:81)

#60  القدير **Al-Qadeer — The All-Powerful**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Qadeer, You have power over all things. Remove my difficulties, cure my illness, and make easy what is hard for me.*

**How to live by it:** When you make du'aa, believe fully in Al-Qadeer's power. Do not limit your requests based on what seems possible to you. His power is unlimited — so let your faith be unlimited.

**Quran:** "Indeed, Allaah is over all things Qadeer (Competent/Able)." Mentioned over 30 times in the Quran.

#61  المقتدر **Al-Muqtadir — The Omnipotent**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Muqtadir, nothing is impossible for You. I ask You for what only Your absolute power can accomplish.*

**How to live by it:** Place your impossible requests before Al-Muqtadir. Healing the incurable, opening the impossible door, changing the unchangeable heart — nothing is beyond Him.

**Quran:** *"In a seat of honor near a Sovereign, Perfect in Ability (Maleek Muqtadir)."* (Al-Qamar 54:55)

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### #62 الجبار **Al-Jabbaar — The Compeller**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Jabbaar, mend my broken heart, restore what is broken in my life, and compel my affairs toward what pleases You.*

**How to live by it:** When your heart is broken, turn to Al-Jabbaar. He mends the brokenhearted. Also, never be a jabbaar (tyrant) over others, as this attribute belongs only to Him.

**Quran:** *"He is Allaah... Al-'Azeez (the Almighty), Al-Jabbaar (the Compeller), Al-Mutakabbir (the Supreme)."* (Al-Hashr 59:23)

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### #63 القاهر **Al-Qaahir — The Subduer**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Qaahir, subdue my enemies and those who wish harm upon the believers, and subdue the evil within my own self.*

**How to live by it:** Submit willingly to Al-Qaahir before you are subdued unwillingly. Voluntary submission is honored; forced submission is humiliation. Choose obedience while you still have the choice.

**Quran:** *"And He is Al-Qaahir (the Subduer) over His servants. And He is the Wise, the Aware."* (Al-An'aam 6:18)

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### #64 القهار **Al-Qahhaar — The Overpowering**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Qahhaar, overpower the tyranny of my nafs and the whispers of Shaytaan, and grant me victory over my weaknesses.*

**How to live by it:** Remember that every tyrant and oppressor will be subdued by Al-Qahhaar. If you witness injustice, have patience and know that no one escapes His overpowering grip.

**Quran:** *"Say: Allaah is the Creator of all things, and He is the One, Al-Qahhaar (the Overpowering)."* (Ar-Ra'd 13:16)

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### #65 المتكبر **Al-Mutakabbir — The Supreme**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Mutakabbir, You alone deserve supreme glory. Remove pride from my heart and replace it with humility before You.*

**How to live by it:** Recognize that pride belongs only to Allaah. Any pride in a human heart is stolen property. Cultivate humility, knowing that the more humble you are before Al-Mutakabbir, the more He elevates you.

**Quran:** *"He is Allaah... Al-Mutakabbir (the Supreme in Glory)."* (Al-Hashr 59:23)

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### #66 الحليم **Al-Haleem — The Forbearing**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Haleem, be forbearing with me for my sins and give me time to repent and correct myself.*

**How to live by it:** Practice hilm (forbearance) in your dealings. When someone wrongs you, do not rush to retaliate. Give them time, as Al-Haleem gives you time. Respond with patience and dignity.

**Quran:** *"And know that Allaah is Ghafoor (Forgiving), Haleem (Forbearing)."* (Al-Baqarah 2:235). Mentioned 11 times in the Quran.

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### #67 الغفار **Al-Ghaffaar — The Oft-Forgiving**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Ghaffaar, I have sinned repeatedly but You forgive repeatedly. Forgive my sins, the old and the new, the hidden and the apparent.*

**How to live by it:** Make istighfaar (seeking forgiveness) a daily habit. The Prophet did it over 70 times daily, despite being sinless. If Al-Ghaffaar forgives again and again, then ask again and again without shame.

**Quran:** "And indeed, I am Al-Ghaffaar (the Perpetual Forgiver) for whoever repents and believes and does righteousness and then continues in guidance." (Ta...

### #68 الغفور Al-Ghafoor — The All-Forgiving

**Du'a:** *Yaa Ghafoor, cover my sins completely and do not expose me on the Day of Judgment. Forgive me a forgiveness that leaves no trace.*

**How to live by it:** When you sin, rush to repent. Do not delay, for Al-Ghafoor is waiting for you. Do not let Shaytaan convince you that your sins are too great — nothing is too great for Al-Ghafoor to forgive.

**Quran:** "Your Lord is full of forgiveness (Ghufoor) for mankind despite their wrongdoing." (Ar-Ra'd 13:6). Mentioned over 70 times.

### #69 العفو Al-'Afuww — The Pardonner

**Du'a:** *Allaahumma innaka 'Afuwwun tuhibbul-'afwa fa'fu 'annee. (O Allaah, You are 'Afuww, You love to pardon, so pardon me.)*

**How to live by it:** This is one of the greatest du'aas. Use it abundantly, especially in the last ten nights of Ramadan. Also pardon others who wrong you, for Al-'Afuww loves those who pardon.

**Quran:** "Indeed, Allaah is 'Afuww (Pardoning) and Ghafoor (Forgiving)." (Al-Mujaadilah 58:2)

### #70 التواب At-Tawwaab — Acceptor of Repentance

**Du'a:** *Yaa Tawwaab, turn to me with mercy so that I may turn to You with repentance. Accept my tawbah and do not let me return to my sins.*

**How to live by it:** Repent immediately after every sin — do not wait. At-Tawwaab turns toward you before you even turn toward Him. He is delighted by your repentance. Make tawbah a daily practice.

**Quran:** "Do they not know that Allaah is the One Who accepts repentance (At-Tawwaab) from His servants?" (At-Tawbah 9:104)

### #71 الشهيد Ash-Shaheed — The Witness

**Du'a:** *Yaa Shaheed, be my witness that I testify there is no god but You, and bear witness to my sincere efforts to please You.*

**How to live by it:** Live your life knowing that every moment is witnessed. This should comfort you (your good deeds are seen) and motivate you (your sins are also seen). Let Ash-Shaheed be the audience you perform for.

**Quran:** "Allaah is Witness (Shaheed) over all things." (Al-Mujaadilah 58:6)

### #72 المهيمن Al-Muhaymin — The Trustworthy Witness

**Du'a:** *Yaa Muhaymin, watch over me and my family with Your care, and guard us from every evil.*

**How to live by it:** Trust Al-Muhaymin's guardianship over all your affairs. He is the most trustworthy overseer. Entrust your concerns to Him and find peace in His watchful care.

**Quran:** "He is Allaah... As-Salaam (the Flawless), Al-Mu'min (the Granter of Security), Al-Muhaymin (the Overseer)." (Al-Hashr 59:23)

### #73 المؤمن Al-Mu'min — Granter of Security

**Du'a:** *Yaa Mu'min, grant me safety and security in my religion, my family, and my Hereafter. Make me safe from Your punishment.*

**How to live by it:** Be a source of security for others. The Prophet (ﷺ) said: "The Muslim is the one from whose tongue and hand other Muslims are safe." Be trustworthy and reliable as a reflection of this Name.

**Quran:** "He is Allaah... Al-Mu'min (the Granter of security)." (Al-Hashr 59:23)

#74  الولي **Al-Waliyy — The Guardian Lord**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Waliyy, be my guardian and protector. Bring me out of the darkness of sin into the light of obedience.*

**How to live by it:** Become a waliyy (friend) of Allaah by drawing near to Him through obligatory and voluntary acts of worship. His friendship is the greatest treasure — pursue it with every ounce of effort.

**Quran:** "Allaah is the Waliyy (Guardian) of those who believe. He brings them out from darkness into light." (Al-Baqarah 2:257)

#75  المولى **Al-Mawlaa — The Patron Lord**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Mawlaa, You are the best of patrons and the best of helpers. Support me and aid me against those who oppose the truth.*

**How to live by it:** When you feel alone or unsupported, remember that Al-Mawlaa is your patron. His support is stronger than any human alliance. "Excellent is the Mawlaa and excellent is the Helper."

**Quran:** "That is because Allaah is the Mawlaa (Patron) of those who believe." (Muhammad 47:11). "Excellent is the Mawlaa and excellent is the Helper." (Al-...

#76  الرقيب **Ar-Raqeeb — The Watchful**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Raqeeb, make me conscious of Your watchful gaze so that I never do in private what I would be ashamed of in public.*

**How to live by it:** Develop taqwaa (God-consciousness) by remembering Ar-Raqeeb in every situation. Before any action, ask yourself: Would I do this if I could see Allaah watching me? The answer is your guide.

**Quran:** "Indeed, Allaah is ever, over you, a Raqeeb (Watcher)." (An-Nisaa' 4:1)

#77  الحفيظ **Al-Hafeedh — The Guardian**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Hafeedh, preserve me from every evil, preserve my faith, and preserve my good deeds so that none of them are lost.*

**How to live by it:** Guard Allaah's commandments and He will guard you. This is the practical formula: obedience to Him earns His protection. Also recite the morning and evening adhkaar, which are shields from Al-Hafeedh.

**Quran:** "For each one are successive angels before and behind him who protect him by the decree of Allaah." (Ar-Ra'd 13:11)

#78  الحافظ **Al-Haafidh — The Protector**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Haafidh, protect my children, my family, and my home from every harm and evil, as You are the best of protectors.*

**How to live by it:** When you entrust your loved ones to Allaah's protection, say the du'aa of protection. Al-Haafidh guards what you cannot. Trust Him with your children when they are beyond your sight.

**Quran:** "And your Lord is not forgetful." (Maryam 19:64). "Allaah is the best Haafidh (Guardian), and He is the most merciful." (Yoosuf 12:64)

#79  المحيط **Al-Muheet — The Encompassing**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Muheet, You encompass all things with Your knowledge and mercy. Encompass me with Your protection and do not let any harm reach me.*

**How to live by it:** Know that nothing is outside Allaah's encompassing — no fear, no problem, no enemy. If Al-Muheet has encompassed everything, then nothing can harm you without His permission, and nothing good can m...

**Quran:** "But Allaah is encompassing (Muheet) of them from behind." (Al-Burooj 85:20). "Allaah encompasses (Muheet) all things." (An-Nisaa' 4:126)

#80  **المقيت Al-Muqet** — *The All-Powerful Maintainer*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Muqet, sustain me with what I need for my body and soul, and maintain my affairs in the best condition.*

**How to live by it:** Trust Al-Muqet for your daily sustenance. He maintains every creature — including you. Do your part (take the means) and leave the results to the One Who maintains all things.

**Quran:** "Allaah is Muqet (Maintainer) over all things." (An-Nisaa' 4:85)

#81  **الواسع Al-Waasi'** — *The Vast*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Waasi', Your mercy is vast and Your treasures are limitless. Expand my provision and my heart, for nothing can contain Your vastness.*

**How to live by it:** Do not limit your du'aa. Ask big, because Al-Waasi' is vast. Do not think your request is too much — His capacity to give is infinitely greater than your capacity to ask.

**Quran:** "To Allaah belongs the east and the west. Wherever you turn, there is the Face of Allaah. Indeed, Allaah is Waasi' (All-Encompassing), 'Aleem (Know..."

#82  **الصادق As-Saadiq** — *The Truthful*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Saadiq, You are the most truthful. Fulfill Your promises to me and make me among the truthful (siddiqeen).*

**How to live by it:** Be truthful in all your affairs, as As-Saadiq loves truthfulness. The Prophet (ﷺ) said: "Truthfulness leads to righteousness, and righteousness leads to Paradise." Cultivate sidq (truthfulness) in ...

**Quran:** "And who is more truthful than Allaah in statement?" (An-Nisaa' 4:87)

#83  **الطيب At-Tayyib** — *The Pure One*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Tayyib, purify my heart, my wealth, and my deeds. Accept from me only what is pure and good.*

**How to live by it:** Ensure that your income, your food, and your speech are tayyib (pure and wholesome). At-Tayyib only accepts what is tayyib. Eat halaal, earn halaal, and speak good words.

**Quran:** The concept is reflected in: "To Him ascends the good (tayyib) word." (Faatir 35:10)

#84  **القدوس Al-Quddoos** — *The Pure & Perfect*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Quddoos, purify me from every sin and impurity. Make me among those who are pure in heart and deed.*

**How to live by it:** Say "Subhaanal-Malikal-Quddoos" after witr prayer. Strive for purity in all aspects: purity of body (wudhoo'), purity of wealth (zakaah), and purity of heart (tawbah).

**Quran:** "He is Allaah... Al-Malik (the King), Al-Quddoos (the Holy)." (Al-Hashr 59:23). "Whatever is in the heavens and whatever is on the earth glorifies ..."

#85  **السلام As-Salaam** — *The Flawless*

**Du'a:** *Allaahumma Antas-Salaam, wa minkas-salaam, tabaarakta yaa Dhal-Jalaali wal-Ikraam. (O Allaah, You are As-Salaam, and from You comes peace.)*

**How to live by it:** Spread salaam (peace) everywhere. The Prophet (ﷺ) said: "Spread salaam among you." Greet others warmly, resolve conflicts, and be a person of peace, reflecting the Name of As-Salaam.

**Quran:** "He is Allaah... As-Salaam (the Flawless/Source of Peace)." (Al-Hashr 59:23). "For them will be the Home of Peace (Salaam) with their Lord." (Al-An...

#86  السبوح As-Subbooh — *The Venerated*

**Du'a:** *Subboohun Quddoosun, Rabbul-malaa'ikati war-rooh. (Glorified, Holy, Lord of the angels and the Spirit.)*

**How to live by it:** Make tasbeeh a constant habit. Say "SubhaanAllaah" abundantly. Join the angels in glorifying As-Subbooh — it is one of the lightest phrases on the tongue but heaviest on the scales.

**Quran:** *The concept is in: "And the angels glorify (yusabbihoon) with praise of their Lord." (Ash-Shooraa 42:5)*

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#87  المجيد Al-Majeed — *The Glorious*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Majeed, honor me with Your closeness and let me share in the glory of serving You.*

**How to live by it:** Send salawaat upon the Prophet (ﷺ) frequently, using the words "innaka Hameedun Majeed." Doing so connects you to Al-Majeed through the best of His creation.

**Quran:** *"Owner of the Throne, Al-Majeed (the Glorious)." (Al-Burooj 85:15). Also in the Ibraahemiyah in tashahhud.*

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#88  الحميد Al-Hameed — *The Praiseworthy*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Hameed, all praise belongs to You. Help me to be among those who praise You abundantly in ease and hardship.*

**How to live by it:** Say "Alhamdulillah" (All praise is for Allaah) frequently and sincerely — after blessings, after eating, after waking up, and even during trials, for Al-Hameed deserves praise in every condition.

**Quran:** *"O mankind, you are those in need of Allaah, while Allaah is Al-Ghaniyy (Free of need), Al-Hameed (the Praiseworthy)." (Faatir 35:15)*

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#89  الشاكر Ash-Shaakir — *The Appreciative*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Shaakir, appreciate my small efforts and reward me beyond what I deserve.*

**How to live by it:** Be grateful to Allaah in every situation. If Ash-Shaakir appreciates even your smallest deed, then no act of worship is too small to do. A smile, a kind word, removing harm from the road — all are ...

**Quran:** *"If you are grateful, I will surely increase you." (Ibraaheem 14:7). "Allaah is Shaakir (Appreciative), 'Aleem (Knowing)." (Al-Baqarah 2:158)*

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#90  الشكور Ash-Shakoor — *The Most Appreciative*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Shakoor, multiply my rewards and do not let any of my deeds go to waste, no matter how small.*

**How to live by it:** Thank people who do good to you, for the Prophet (ﷺ) said: "Whoever does not thank people has not thanked Allaah." Being thankful to people pleases Ash-Shakoor.

**Quran:** *"So that He may pay them in full their rewards and increase them from His bounty. Indeed, He is Ghafoor (Forgiving), Shakoor (Appreciative)." (Faat...*

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#91  الحسيب Al-Haseeb — *The Reckoner*

**Du'a:** *HasbiyAllaahu wa ni'mal-wakeel. (Allaah is sufficient for me, and He is the best disposer of affairs.)*

**How to live by it:** Say "HasbiyAllaahu wa ni'mal-wakeel" in times of distress. Also be careful about your deeds, knowing that Al-Haseeb is taking full account. His reckoning misses nothing.

**Quran:** *"Is not Allaah sufficient (Haseeb) for His servant?" (Az-Zumar 39:36). "Allaah is sufficient as a Reckoner (Haseeb)." (An-Nisaa' 4:6)*

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#92  الحق Al-Haqq — *The Truth*

**Du'a:** *Yaa Haqq, show me the truth as truth and grant me the ability to follow it, and show me falsehood as falsehood and grant me the ability to avoid it.*

**How to live by it:** Stand with the truth always, even when it is difficult. Al-Haqq is the Truth, and those who align themselves with truth are aligned with Him. Never compromise truth for convenience.

**Quran:** "That is because Allaah is Al-Haqq (the Truth)." (Al-Hajj 22:6). "Say: The truth has come, and falsehood has departed." (Al-Israa' 17:81)

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### #93 المبين **Al-Mubeen — The Manifest**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Mubeen, make the truth clear to me in every matter and do not let me be confused by falsehood.*

**How to live by it:** Study the Quran and Sunnah to see the clear evidence of Al-Mubeen. When confused about any matter, return to His clear revelation for guidance. The truth is manifest — seek it sincerely.

**Quran:** "On that Day, Allaah will pay them in full their just due, and they will know that Allaah is Al-Haqq, Al-Mubeen (the Manifest Truth)." (An-Noor 24:25)

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### #94 الوكيل **Al-Wakeel — The Trustee**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Wakeel, I entrust all my affairs to You. Dispose of them in the way that is best for me, even if it differs from what I want.*

**How to live by it:** Practice tawakkul (reliance on Allaah) by doing your best effort and then leaving the results to Al-Wakeel. Tie your camel and then trust in Allaah. Do not be passive, but do not be anxious either.

**Quran:** "And whoever relies upon Allaah — He is sufficient for him." (At-Talaaq 65:3). "Allaah is sufficient as a Wakeel (Disposer of affairs)." (An-Nisaa'...)

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### #95 المقدم **Al-Muqaddim — The Advancer**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Muqaddim, advance me in faith, knowledge, and closeness to You. Place me among the foremost in good deeds.*

**How to live by it:** Race toward good deeds. Al-Muqaddim advances those who strive. Do not procrastinate in worship or in doing good. Be among the saabiqaen (foremost) who rush toward righteousness.

**Quran:** *The concept is found in verses about Allaah raising some people above others in rank and status according to His wisdom.*

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### #96 المؤخر **Al-Mu'akhkhir — The Delayer**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Mu'akhkhir, delay from me every harm and evil, and if something I desire is not good for me, delay it until the right time or replace it with better.*

**How to live by it:** When something you want is delayed, practice patience. Al-Mu'akhkhir's delay is purposeful. Perhaps you are being protected, or perhaps something better is being prepared. Trust His timing.

**Quran:** *The concept is in: "Allaah does not delay a soul when its time has come." (Al-Munaafiqoon 63:11)*

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### #97 القريب **Al-Qareeb — The Near**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Qareeb, You are near — nearer to me than my jugular vein. Draw me closer to You and do not let me drift away.*

**How to live by it:** Make sujood frequently and lengthen it, for that is when you are closest to Al-Qareeb. Make du'aa in sujood abundantly. He is near — you do not need an intermediary to reach Him.

**Quran:** "And when My servants ask you about Me, indeed I am Qareeb (Near). I respond to the invocation of the supplicant when he calls upon Me." (Al-Baqara...)

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### #98 المجيب **Al-Mujeeb — The Responsive**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Mujeeb, respond to my du'aa and do not turn me away. You have promised to respond, and Your promise is true.*

**How to live by it:** Never stop making du'aa. Al-Mujeeb has promised to respond, and He never breaks a promise. Observe the etiquettes of du'aa: face the qiblah, praise Allaah, send salawaat on the Prophet, and be sinc...

**Quran:** "Indeed, my Lord is Near (Qareeb), Responsive (Mujeeb)." (Hood 11:61)

### #99 الشافي Ash-Shaafee — The Healer

**Du'a:** Allaahummash-fi, Antash-Shaafee, laa shifaa'a illaa shifaa'uk, shifaa'an laa yughaadiru saqamaa. (O Allaah, cure; You are the Curer. There is no cure except Your cure, a cure that leaves no illness.)

**How to live by it:** When ill, use this prophetic du'aa. Take medicine (as a means) but believe the cure is from Ash-Shaafee alone. Also recite Quran over the sick — it is a healing for what is in the hearts and the bo...

**Quran:** The concept is in: "And when I am ill, it is He Who cures me." (Ash-Shu'araa' 26:80 — words of Ibraaheem)

### #100 الكافي Al-Kafi — The Sufficient

**Du'a:** Yaa Kafi, You are sufficient for me against everything that worries me. Suffice me in my religion, my worldly life, and my Hereafter.

**How to live by it:** Whenever anxiety grips you, remind yourself: Al-Kafi is sufficient. You do not need anyone else. Reduce your dependence on people and increase your dependence on the One Who is truly sufficient.

**Quran:** "Is not Allaah sufficient (Kaafin) for His servant?" (Az-Zumar 39:36)

### #101 النصير An-Naseer — The Helper

**Du'a:** Yaa Naseer, help me against my enemies, help me against my nafs, and grant victory to the believers everywhere.

**How to live by it:** Seek Allaah's help (nusrah) in all your struggles — not just wars, but struggles against temptation, laziness, and doubt. An-Naseer's help comes to those who strive and call upon Him sincerely.

**Quran:** "And sufficient is your Lord as a Guide and a Naseer (Helper)." (Al-Furqaan 25:31). "Excellent is the protector and excellent is the Naseer (Helper)..."

### #102 الوارث Al-Waarith — The Inheritor

**Du'a:** Yaa Waarith, You inherit all things. Let me send forward good deeds before the day when nothing I own will remain with me.

**How to live by it:** Detach from material possessions. Everything you have is temporary and will be inherited by Al-Waarith. Invest in good deeds, which are the only wealth that will remain with you after everything is...

**Quran:** "And indeed, it is We Who give life and cause death, and We are the Waarith (Inheritor)." (Al-Hijr 15:23)

### #103 الجميل Al-Jameel — The Beautiful

**Du'a:** Yaa Jameel, You are Beautiful and You love beauty. Beautify my character, my speech, and my deeds. Let me see Your Beautiful Face in Paradise.

**How to live by it:** Pursue beauty in all forms — beauty in your worship, beauty in your character, beauty in your appearance, and beauty in how you treat others. Al-Jameel loves beauty, so make your entire life beauti...

**Quran:** The concept is reflected throughout the Quran in descriptions of the beauty of His creation and the ultimate beauty of seeing His Face in Paradise.

### #104 المحسن Al-Muhsin — The Doer of Good

**Du'a:** *Yaa Muhsin, make me a muhsin (doer of good and excellence) in my worship, in my dealings, and in every action I take.*

**How to live by it:** Strive for ihsaan (excellence) in everything you do — from how you pray, to how you work, to how you treat your family. The Prophet said Allaah has prescribed ihsaan in everything, even in how you ...

**Quran:** *The concept is reflected in: "Who perfected everything He created." (As-Sajdah 32:7)*

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#105  **السَّيِّئِر As-Sitteer — The Concealer of Sins**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Sitteer, conceal my faults from the people, do not expose my sins, and help me to overcome them in secret.*

**How to live by it:** Conceal the faults of others, and As-Sitteer will conceal yours. The Prophet (ﷺ) said: "Whoever covers a Muslim, Allaah will cover him." Never expose people's sins or gossip about their mistakes.

**Quran:** *The concept is in: "Allaah does not like the public mention of evil." (An-Nisaa' 4:148 — indicating He prefers concealment)*

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#106  **الدَّيَّان Ad-Dayyaan — The Supreme Judge**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Dayyaan, judge me with Your mercy and not with Your justice, for if You judge me with justice alone, I will be destroyed.*

**How to live by it:** Hold yourself accountable before Ad-Dayyaan holds you accountable. Review your deeds daily, repent for shortcomings, and prepare for the Day when every deed will be weighed.

**Quran:** *The concept is in: "Master of the Day of Judgment (Yawm ad-Deen)." (Al-Faatihah 1:4). The word deen here means recompense/judgment.*

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#107  **ذو الجلال والإكرام Dhul-Jalaali wal-Ikraam — Possessor of Majesty & Honor**

**Du'a:** *Yaa Dhal-Jalaali wal-Ikraam, honor me with Your forgiveness and bestow upon me from Your majesty and generosity.*

**How to live by it:** Say this Name frequently after prayers, as the Prophet encouraged. Let the combination of His majesty (which inspires awe) and His honor/generosity (which inspires love) create in your heart a beau...

**Quran:** *"Blessed is the Name of your Lord, Dhul-Jalaali wal-Ikraam (Owner of Majesty and Honor)." (Ar-Rahmaan 55:78)*

<b>Angry</b>	Al-Haleem (#66), Ar-Rafeeq (#17), Al-'Afuww (#69)	Allah is Al-Haleem — so patient with everyone. If He can be patient with all of creation, you can be patient with one person!
<b>Feeling Proud or Show-Offy</b>	Al-Mutakabbir (#65), Al-Kabeer (#54), Al-'Adheem (#55), Al-Ghaniyy (#34)	Remember, true greatness belongs ONLY to Allah. We are just small servants who own nothing. Stay humble!
<b>Hopeless</b>	Al-Fattaah (#40), Al-Qadeer (#60), At-Tawwaab (#70), Al-Lateef (#29), Al-Wahhaab (#25)	Al-Fattaah opens doors that seem locked forever. NOTHING is too hard for Al-Qadeer. Your situation can change in a second!
<b>Weak or Tired</b>	Al-Qawiyy (#57), Al-'Azeez (#56), Al-Mateen (#58), An-Naseer (#101), Al-Mawlaa (#75)	Say 'Laa hawla wa laa quwwata illaa billaah' — your strength is limited, but Al-Qawiyy's strength has NO limit!
<b>Tempted to Do Wrong</b>	Ar-Raqeeb (#76), Al-Baseer (#47), As-Sitteer (#105), Al-Hafeedh (#77), Al-'Azeez (#56)	Remember Ar-Raqeeb is watching! If you resist, Al-Hafeedh protects you. If you slip, As-Sitteer will cover you if you repent.
<b>Impatient</b>	Al-Haleem (#66), Al-Hakeem (#42), Al-Khabeer (#45), Al-Lateef (#29)	Al-Haleem is patient with all creation. Al-Lateef is working behind the scenes. Trust His timing — what feels slow is perfectly timed!
<b>Overwhelmed</b>	Al-Wakeel (#94), Al-Kafi (#100), Al-Mu'tee (#24), Al-Qawiyy (#57), Al-Baasit (#22), Ar-Rafeeq (#17)	Al-Wakeel manages what you cannot. Al-Kafi is enough for every need. Take it one step at a time — Ar-Rafeeq teaches gentleness with yourself too!
<b>Far from Allah</b>	Al-Qareeb (#97), At-Tawwaab (#70), Al-Wadood (#13), Al-Hafiy (#16), Al-Ghaffaar (#67)	He is Al-Qareeb — always near. At-Tawwaab is waiting for you. Take one step toward Him and He'll come running toward you!
